

Benefits of Compost

Production System:

Yard waste and food waste are collected locally then mixed with wood chips from local arboriculture.

Compost is considered a soil amendment, rather than a fertilizer. It contains both the macronutrients and micronutrients required for plant growth, whereas most chemical fertilizers only supply macronutrients.

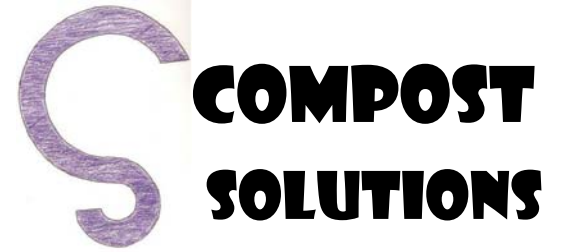
